



Dear Parish Family,

In our on-going journey to care for God's creation I am going to encourage all committee's to be more conscious of the use of printed materials, specifically, flyers in the bulletin. There is a practical and spiritual aspect to being better stewards of this resource.

On the practical side: most flyers are discarded and therefore kind of a waste of paper. Also if we print order sheets the same thing happens. Hypothetically, (but probably close to truth) if we print 500 order forms, 50 are used; better to simply make them available at the entrances for those who will actually be using them. I encourage everyone to utilize our website for the dissimilation of information. I am aware that not everyone uses modern technology and with that in mind we should have some hard copies but not an overabundance. Moreover, it costs money, not that money is our sole motivator, it still costs an exorbitant amount of money for us to print materials that could be delivered by other means. We are not going to eliminate printed materials but we can reduce our use of them.

Why is this a spiritual issue? Because there are limited resources on our planet, we, disciples, care takers of God's creation, of all people on the planet, should be more conscientious of wastefulness of limited resources. If we kill less trees, we reverse adverse effects on our ecosystem. Trees make oxygen, a kind of vital chemical element. More trees = more oxygen! More oxygen more opportunity to breathe in the breath of God! Trees are carbon sync...that means they take carbon out of the atmosphere and create the oxygen.
