**Pastoral Council Goals 2017—2018**

1. **CHAIRPERSON COMMENTS:** Mark reminded the Council to check their mailboxes for any paperwork, for example, Time Talent and Treasure surveys.
2. **OPEN FORUM:** No guests
3. **ADDITIONAL :** None
4. **REVIEW/ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING:** Rachael motioned to accept the minutes and Jerry seconded and consensus was reached.
5. **OLD BUSINESS:** On April 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> Nomination forms will be in the pews. Ushers will assist as needed. Grace, Kathy and Al will assist the committee and tally results after Sunday Mass. On May 15<sup>th</sup> there will be an orientation for new members if needed.
6. **NEW BUSINESS:** Social Ministry discussed if Pastoral Council approval is needed before acting upon activities, such as petitions. Discussion by PC followed. It was determined that if any activity of any committee that affects the whole parish has not been previously approved it will need to be approved by Pastoral Council. Also, there was some discussion involving the change of names for the Social Ministry to Human Concerns Ministry. Also, a tentative statement of Pastoral Goals for 2018 -2019 was discussed. These goals will be reviewed by the Chairpersons of each committee.

**Social ministry/HOPE:** Kathy reported and Father Bill motioned to accept the minutes and Al seconded and consensus was reached.

**Liturgy:** Barb deferred to the minutes. Al motioned to accept the minutes and Debbie seconded and consensus was reached.

**Faith Formation:** Billie deferred to the minutes. Jerry motioned to accept the minutes and Michael seconded and consensus was reached.

**Facilities:** John deferred to the minutes. Joe motioned to accept the minutes and Debbie seconded and consensus was reached.

8. **PASTORAL LEADER COMMENTS:** Father Bill reported on Time Talent and Treasure survey stating there were 199 returns and \$223,906.00 pledged. The CMA report **stated** 210 donors, 41% of households, pledged \$ 43, 245.48 and \$40,941.27 paid and \$1903.75 outstanding, and we reached 103.7% of our goal and about \$1,500.00 will be returned to us when all is completed. Father Bill also discussed the position of Jim Padetti, a financial consultant for the diocese for our parish and other parishes.
9. **OPEN FORUM FOR MEMBERS:** Grace commented on the dedication and motivation of the choir during this transition time of the music ministry.
10. **CLOSING PRAYER:** Joe gave a very thoughtful prayer to conclude our meeting.
