

Masses Have Resumed at SEAS!

Saturday Mass is at 5PM and Sunday Mass is at 9:30AM

Please share this information with family and friends who might not have email.

We are limited to 33% capacity. Which means we must limit those in attendance to around 110.

Who is Admitted?

Due to the limited number we allowed in the building during Mass – PLEASE be understanding and follow the directions below!

To attend either Saturday/Sunday Mass:

1. **You must call the office** 964-8627 or email during the week prior to the Mass you wish to attend. Office is open from 8:30AM to 3:30PM – you must speak to Sharon to confirm.
 1. Stating which Mass, Number and Names of those to attend.
 2. Reservations will be accepted on a “first come first served” basis.
 3. Please keep in mind that with our limited numbers.
 4. You might need to be open to attend a Mass other than your normal Mass time.

CDC Rules and requirements:

- ALL MUST WEAR A MASK – FACE COVERING THAT COVERS THE NOSE, MOUTH AND CHIN.
- ALL MUST MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING OF 6 FEET AT ALL TIMES.

THINGS TO KNOW:

- All must use the front doors for entering and exiting. No one may use the side doors or the Chapel doors.
- Doors will be propped open to avoid the need to touch the doors.
- In order to limit touch points: Bathrooms, drinking fountains, and all rooms other than the Narthex and the Main Worshiping space will closed.
 - In the event of an emergency – please see the Sacristan or Usher if the bathroom is needed.
 - There will be No Children’s liturgy of the Word and the Family Chapel will not be available.
- There will be no gathering in the Narthex, doorways, or parking lot – 6ft Social Distancing must be maintained at all times.
- Follow all directions of the Usher/Sacristan/Staff.
- IF you move chairs to accommodate same household families – we ask that you return the chairs to their original space.
- Hand sanitizer is available for use at the entrance of the church.

Book of Intentions:

- The Book of Intentions will not be available at this time.
 - If you wish to have prayers brought up to the altar at Mass – Please write your prayer on a small piece of paper and bring to Mass with you.

- There will be a basket available as you enter for you to place your prayer slip.
- The basket will be brought up to the altar during the Offertory by an Usher.

Mass Instructions:

- Please Check in as you enter – this will be used in the event that we need to do contact tracing.
- The Collection Basket will be available at the entrance for you to place your contribution.
Collection during Mass will not take place at this time.
- **Distribution of Communion:**
 - Communion will only be available under the species of the Bread.
 - Proceed up the center aisle in two rows.
 - You must wear your mask/face covering.
 - Keep a 6 feet distance at all times.
 - Communion will be distributed in the hand.
 - Once you receive you may step aside to lower your mask to consume.
- Bulletins will be available on a table in the Narthex for Non-contact distribution.
